

- Founded 2003 by Dave Isay from a MacArthur Genius Grant
- National Media organization
- Oral History Project
- Mission:
  - Preserve + share humanity's stories to:
    - Build connections between people
    - Create a more just and compassionate world

- StoryCorps' Newest Initiative
- Launched 2016
- To preserve and amplify the stories of people whose lives have been impacted by mass incarceration and the justice system nationwide

  - Staff training and facilitator support



### **Interview Collection**

- Signature Interviews
  - The foundation of StoryCorps' work
- Recording Days
  - Centered on participant agency and deeply informed consent
     Presence of SCJP Manager









### **Archives**

- Participants choose to archive their recordings
  - Library of Congress
  - Smithsonian Museum of African American History and
  - Benson Collection at University of Texas Austin
- Partnerships can build local community archives Hartford Public Library
- SCJP creating a community archive with MacArthur Safety and Justice Challenge Network
