



# System Diversions in Western South Dakota

**Problem:**  
Low-level misdemeanor charges cause the Pennington County Criminal Justice System to expend millions of dollars in resources.

**1,102** individuals, **16%** of law enforcement referrals were admitted to the Care Campus with **NO CHARGES FILED.**

Rapid City Police Department: \$150 per detainment

Pennington County Jail: \$88 per day

Pennington County States Attorney's Office: \$25 per misdemeanor file prosecuted

Pennington County Public Defender's Office: \$450 per misdemeanor file defended

Pennington County Court House: \$86.50 expenses factored for misdemeanor files at present time

**\$796.50** per individual jail diversion x 1,050 admissions diverted to Care Campus Programs = **\$836,325**

\*52 individuals were not assigned a program type and are not reflected in this chart.

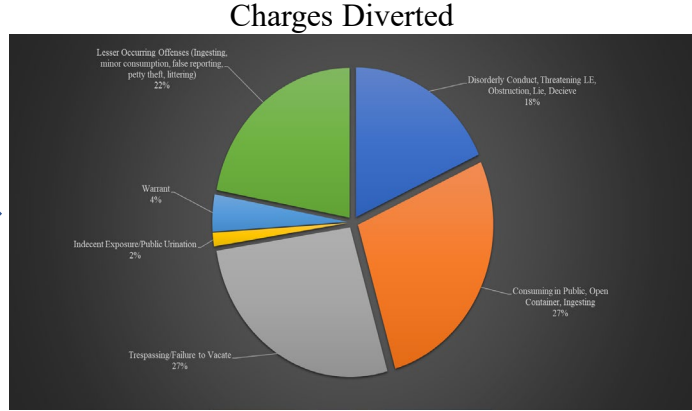
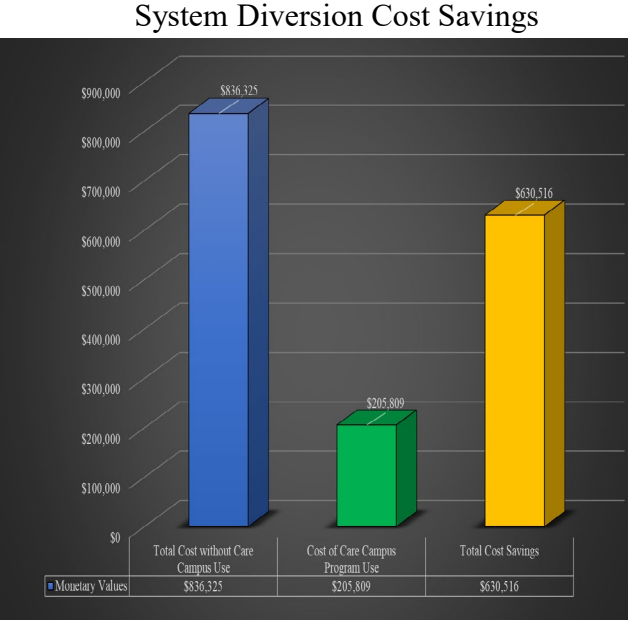
Detoxification costs (\$226 per day/24-hour period) x 709 admissions = **\$160,234**

Safe Solutions costs (\$25 per day/24-hour period) x 151 admissions = **\$3,775**

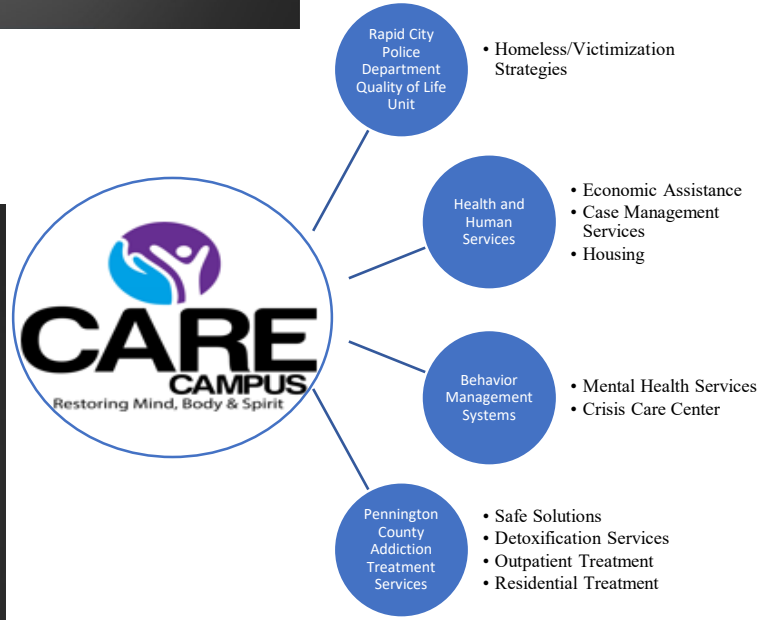
Isolation costs (\$226 per day/24-hour period) x 178 admissions = **\$40,228**

Crisis Care Center costs (\$131 per day/24-hour period) x 12 admissions = **\$1,572**

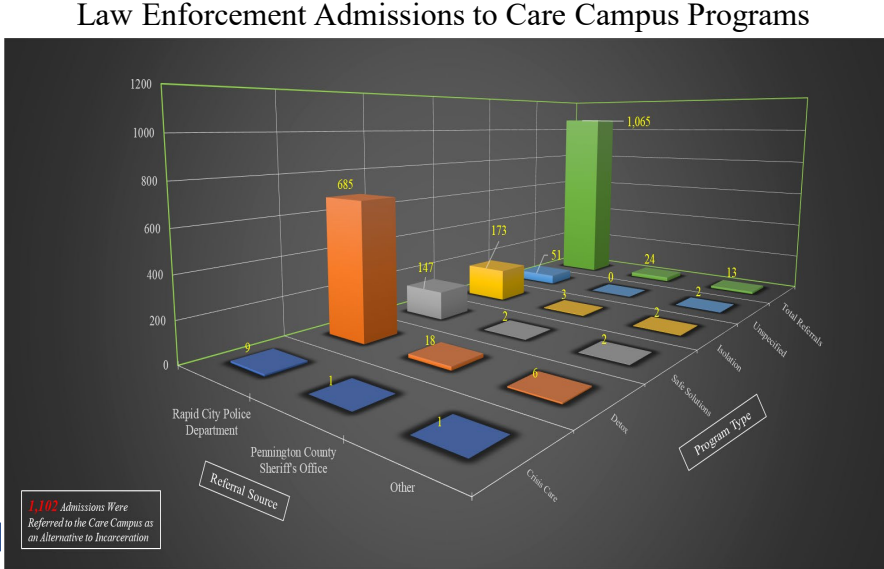
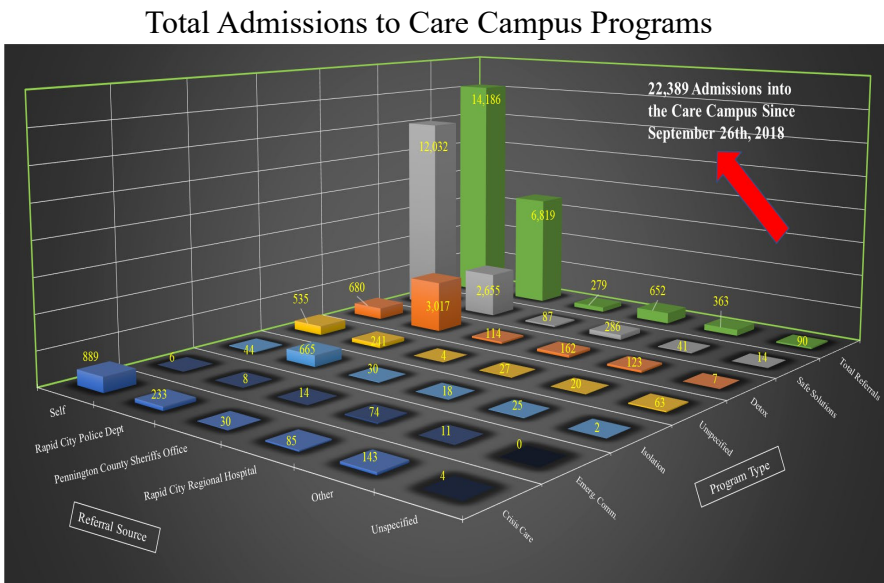
**Total Care Campus Program Use Expenses as an Alternative to Incarceration = \$205,809**



**Response:**  
The Care Campus is a single point of entry system which diverts individuals into services, rather than the Pennington County Jail or emergency services.



**Outcomes:**  
Care Campus data demonstrates misdemeanor crime diversions resulted in hundreds of thousands of dollars in cost savings while increasing public safety and providing the RIGHT SERVICES AT THE RIGHT TIME
