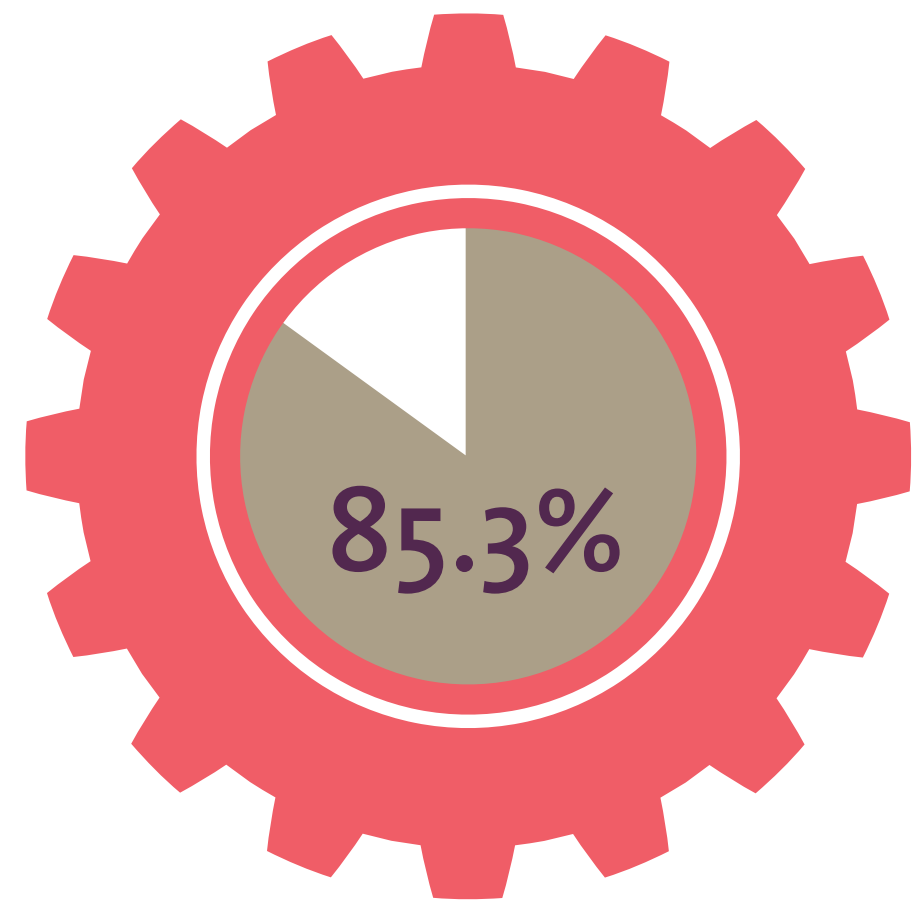

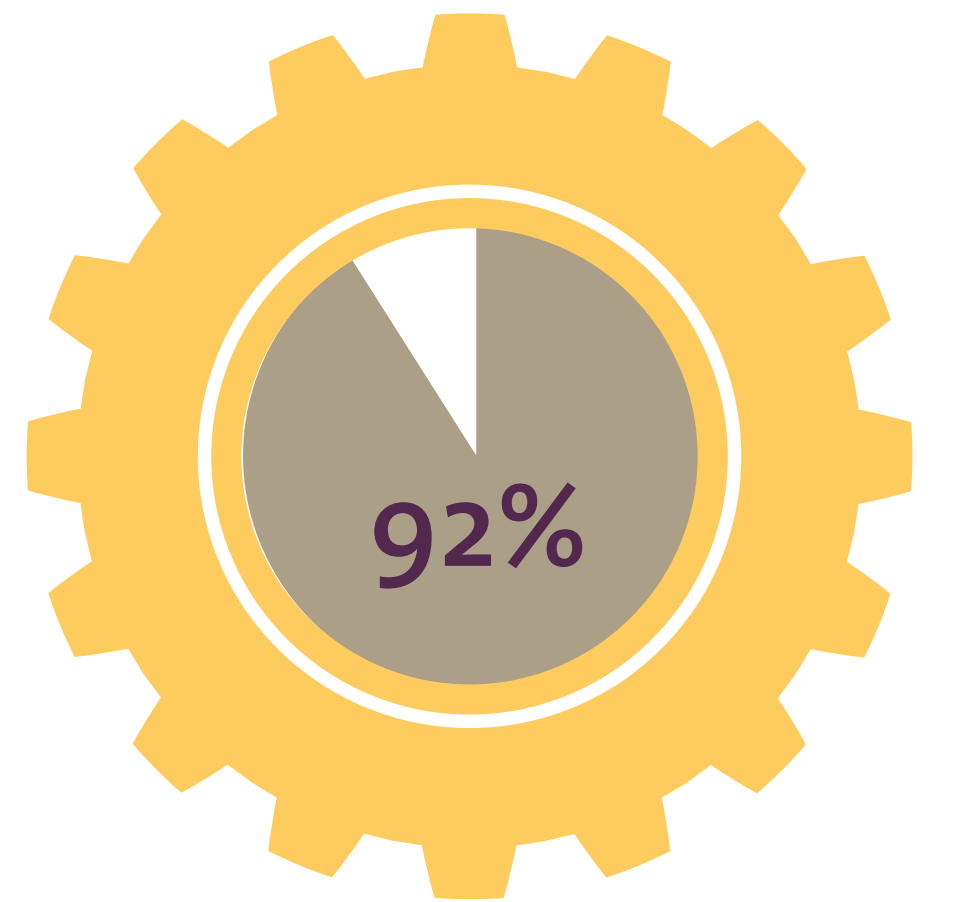
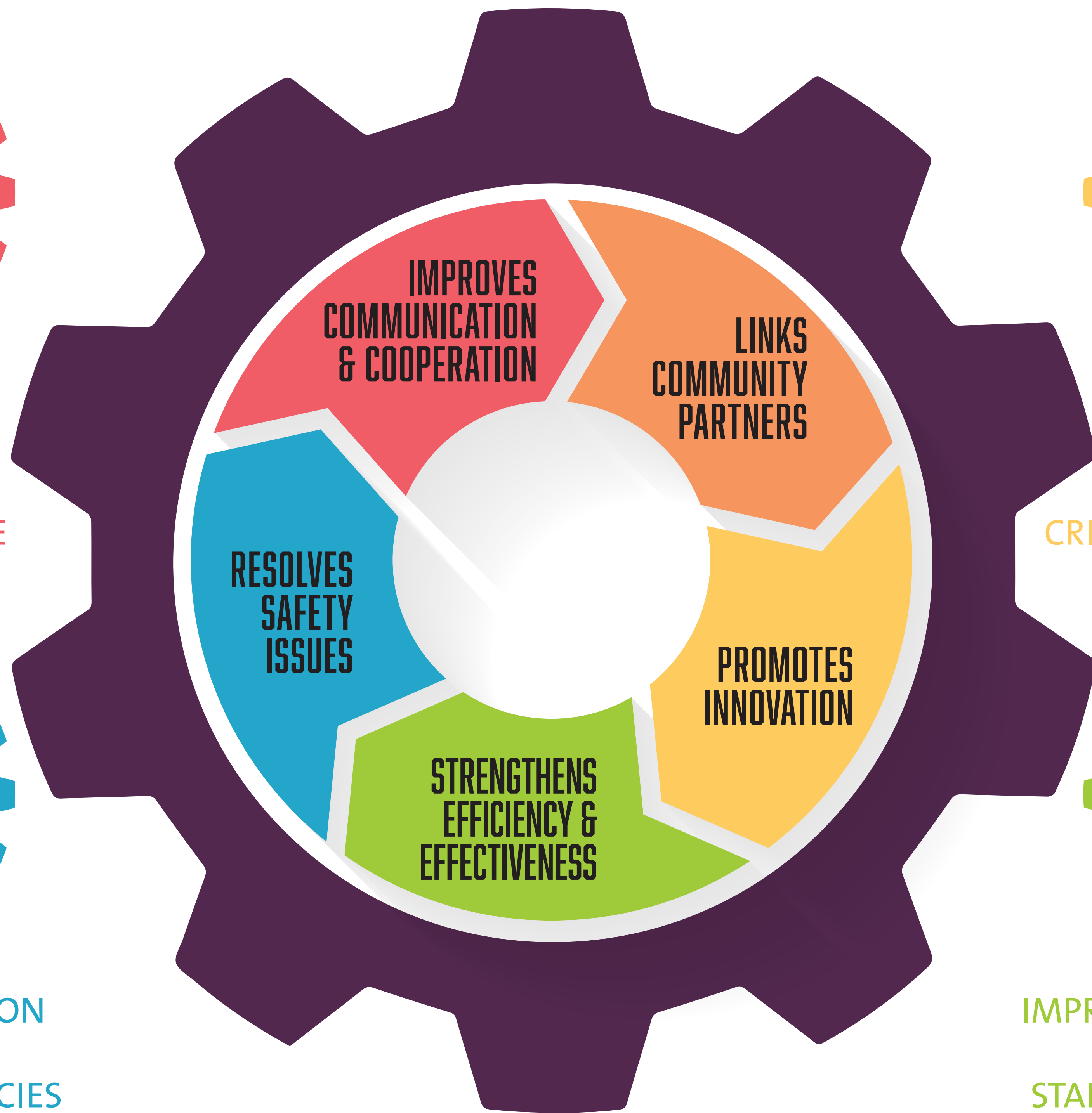
CJCC MEMBERS REPORTED THAT THEIR LOCAL COORDINATING COUNCIL

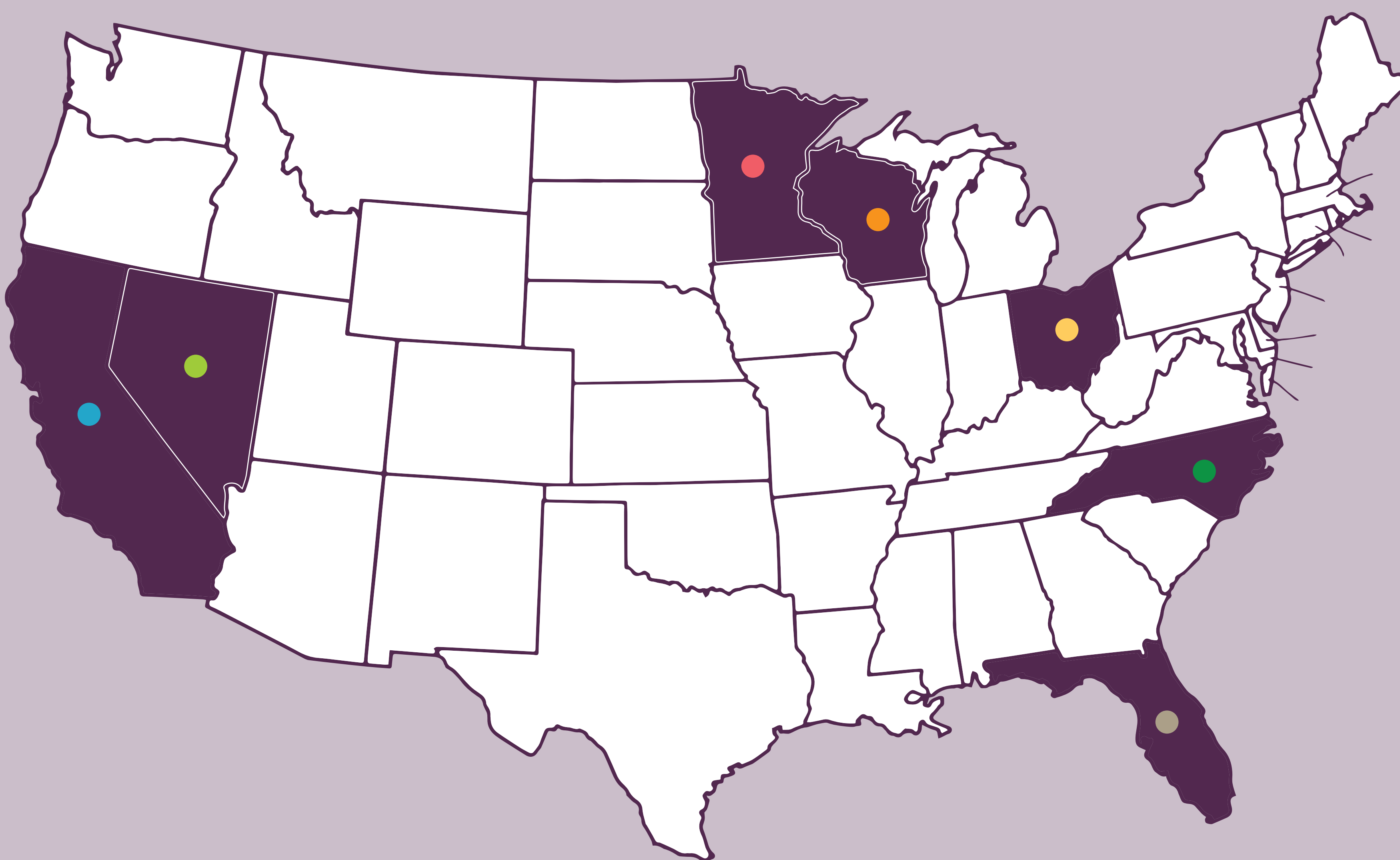
