- \* CRP is a mobile crisis team that strives to address the needs of **Regional Center** individuals with developmental disabilities by providing both phone and face-to-face support.
- \* CRP works specifically to decrease <u>unnecessary</u> police involvement and psychiatric hospitalization.
- \* CRP attempts to increase the <u>success</u> of consumers in the community and staff's ability to handle **future crises**.

#### Who does CRP serve?

CRP serves consumers with developmental disabilities who receive <u>Regional Center</u> services: autism, intellectual disability, cerebral palsy, epilepsy. Many consumers that CRP serves are <u>dually diagnosed</u> with developmental disabilities and mental health disorders.
