
REIMAGINE JUSTICE

 - dignity, and parsimony




















The Square One Project - In Practice

- \rightarrow The problem:
 - Shrinking budgets
 - Increasing social/public health problems
 - ROI is poor
 - The *right* services don't exist
 - Big holes in the safety nets

 - Created an agenda that illuminates the need to think differently about human behavior


